A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO CLARIFY CERTAIN PROVISIONS CONTAINED IN THE ACTS
2 AUTHORIZING CERTAIN CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS.

4 Whereas, the University of North Carolina Hospitals at Chapel Hill (" UNC
5 Hospitals") is in need of certain facilities including: (i) an Administrative Office
6 Building for UNC Hospitals; (ii) the North Carolina Neuropsychiatric Hospital; and
7 (iii) UNC Hospitals' Chiller Expansion Project (items (i), (ii), and (iii) being referred to
8 herein as a "Project"); and

9 Whereas, by Chapters 785 and 965 of the 1989 Session Laws and Chapter
10 657 of the 1991 Session Laws (the "Authorizing Acts"), the General Assembly
11 authorized and approved the financing of the costs of constructing each of the Projects;
12 and

13 Whereas, each Project is to be a self-liquidating project, to be financed
14 through the issuance of the University of North Carolina Board of Governors Revenue
15 Bonds, such revenue bonds to be paid from sources other than appropriated funds; and

16 Whereas, in each of the Authorizing Acts a dollar amount was listed; Now,
17 therefore,

18 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

19 Section 1. Chapter 785 of the 1989 Session Laws is amended by adding a
20 new section to read:

21 "Sec. 2.1. The dollar amount listed in Section 2 of this act applies only to the
22 construction costs of the project."

23 Sec. 2. Chapter 965 of the 1989 Session Laws, as amended by Chapter 590,
24 Session Laws of 1991, is amended by adding a new section to read:

1 "Sec. 2.1. The dollar amounts listed in Section 2 of this act apply only to the
2 construction costs of the respective projects."

3 Sec. 3. Chapter 657 of the 1991 Session Laws is amended by adding a new
4 section to read:

5 "Sec. 2.1. The dollar amounts listed in Section 2 of this act apply only to the
6 construction costs of the respective projects."

7 Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification.
