A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO DIVIDE NORTH CAROLINA INTO TWELVE CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICTS.

Whereas, the congressional redistricting plan contained herein was ratified by the 1991 General Assembly on July 9, 1991, as Chapter 601 of the 1991 Session Laws and submitted to the United States Department of Justice for preclearance as required by Section 5 of the Voting Rights Act of 1965; and

Whereas, the United States Department of Justice denied preclearance to this plan on December 18, 1991, stating certain objections to the ratified plan; and

Whereas, the General Assembly in this extra session needs a bill before it so that it may determine if it is feasible to change the ratified plan to overcome the objections of the Department of Justice; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 163-201 reads as rewritten:

**"§ 163-201. Congressional districts specified.**

(a) For the purpose of nominating and electing members of the House of Representatives of the Congress of the United States in ~~1982-1992~~ and every two years thereafter, the State of North Carolina shall be divided into ~~11~~ 12 districts as follows:
