1 A JOINT RESOLUTION FURTHER ADJOURNING THE 2011 REGULAR SESSION OF
2 THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO A DATE CERTAIN AND LIMITING THE MATTERS
3 THAT MAY BE CONSIDERED UPON RECONVENING.

4 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring:

5 **SECTION 1.** When the Senate and the House of Representatives adjourn on
6 Thursday, July 28, 2011, they stand adjourned to reconvene on Monday, September 12, 2011,
7 at 12:00 noon.

8 **SECTION 2.** During the regular session that reconvenes on Monday, September
9 12, 2011, only the following matters may be considered:

10 (1) Bills:

- 11 a. Revising the Senate districts and the apportionment of Senators
12 among those districts.
- 13 b. Revising the Representative districts and the apportionment of
14 Representatives among those districts.
- 15 c. Revising the districts for the election of members of the House of
16 Representatives of the Congress of the United States and the
17 apportionment of Representatives among those districts.
- 18 d. Bills responding to actions related to the Voting Rights Act of 1965.
- 19 e. Bills responding to actions related to litigation concerning
20 Congressional, State House, or State Senate districts.

21 (2) Bills returned by the Governor with her objections under Section 22 of
22 Article II of the Constitution of North Carolina, but solely for the purpose of
23 considering overriding of the veto upon reconsideration of the bill.

24 (3) Bills in which the General Assembly makes an appointment or appointments
25 to public office and which contain no other matter.

26 (4) Bills:

- 27 a. Proposing an amendment or amendments to the Constitution of
28 North Carolina and containing no other matter.
- 29 b. Proposing an amendment or amendments to the Constitution of
30 North Carolina and containing no other matter other than statutory
31 conforming changes to implement such bills.
- 32 c. Bills that solely make statutory and transitional changes to
33 implement bills under sub-subdivision a. of this subdivision.

34 (5) Any bills relating to election laws.

35 (6) Adoption of conference reports for bills which were in conference as of
36 Thursday, July 28, 2011.



- 1 (7) Joint resolutions proposing a joint session to consider confirmation of the
2 Governor's appointments to the State Board of Education pursuant to
3 G.S. 115C-10.
4 (8) Joint resolutions confirming the Governor's appointments to the State Board
5 of Education pursuant to G.S. 115C-10.
6 (9) Local bills pending in the House Rules Committee on July 28, 2011.
7 (10) Bills to ratify and make statutory conforming changes pursuant to a Tribal
8 Compact negotiated by the Governor.
9 (11) A joint resolution further adjourning the 2011 Regular Session to a date
10 certain.
11 **SECTION 3.** This resolution is effective upon ratification.
